Read Philippians 2:5-11

5a. List the points which Paul makes about Jesus in these verses.

- b. Paul makes it very clear that Jesus is in nature God (verses 6 and 9). Discuss the link in this passage between this fact as to who Jesus is and his saving work for all people.
