PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU WISH TO SEND GOODS OTHER THAN LISTED, OR SEND GOODS TO MISSIONARIES; PLEASE CONTACT A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE FIRST.

CLOTHING - NEW ONLY

- MEN – suits, shirts (esp. white), ties, jackets, trousers, jumpers, cardigans, overalls.
- CLERGY – robes, shirts, collars.
- WOMEN – blouses, shirts, skirts (mid-calf length), sleeved dresses, cardigans, jackets, nurses uniforms, wedding gowns.
- CHILDREN – blouses, skirts, dresses, long shorts, shirts, jumpers, cardigans.
- GENERAL – shoes, new socks, raincoats, new underwear, pvc rain capes, caps.

LINEN - NEW ONLY

Single sheets, wool, cotton and polar fleece blankets, pillow slips, towels, facecloths, nappies, Communion linen, medical drapes, trolley covers, mosquito nets (ex-army style), handkerchiefs.

MISCELLANEOUS

ALL NEW Good quality brands of netballs, tennis and soccer balls. Musical instruments. Torch and size D batteries or wind-up style torches, balloons, hurricane lanterns. Spectacles - metal frame only, no lenses, clean.

SEWING, KNITTING, CRAFT

LENGTHS of cotton/cotton mix material only. Sewing thread, pins, needles, scissors, shears, unpickers, elastic, buttons, hooks/eyes, press studs, bias binding, laces, zips, ribbons, Velcro tape, braids. Dye for tie dyeing. 8-ply wool, needles and crochet hooks, tape measures.

Only Singer Sewing machines (manual or electric) in good working order. Manuals and accessories - needles, bobbins, oil, needle threader. **Please do not send any other brand.**

KITCHEN EQUIPMENT

Melamine bowls (pasta), plates, mugs. Trays, oval platters. All types of spoons: serving and wooden. Carving and peeling knives. LARGE boilers, teapots. Stainless steel thermos flasks. Tea towels, dish cloths, Chux cloths, pot holders. White candles, mop/broom heads, buckets, wash up bowls. Rubber gloves, cockroach baits.

STATIONERY & OFFICE SUPPLIES

Paper: A4/foolscap. Printing/typing/computer/lecture/writing pads. Exercise books. Display books. Manila and plastic folders. All sizes of envelopes. ONLY NEW bios, lead and coloured pencils, chalk (thin/thick) crayons. SINGLE HOLE sharpeners, scissors, paper and bulldog clips, rulers, drawing pins, Blu-tack, hole punch, maths instruments, cello tape, stapler, staples, gluesticks. Correction pens, whiteboard markers, chalk and dusters, guillotine, rulers, stickers, labels, manila folders, filing cabinets. Portable typewriters and ribbons.

TOOLS

Quality tools, clean, rust-free, in good working order. (NO cheap imports please). Hammers, screwdrivers, chisels, files, planes, saws, axes, pliers, drill bits, hacksaw and blades, spanners, rulers, nails, screws, nuts/bolts. Plumbing, metal and leather working tools. Car and bicycle repair kits, puncture kits. Gardening Tools – hoe, spade, fork, rakes (NO small hand tools). Instruction manuals - wood and metal work, building construction, car maintenance, agriculture.

THINGS TO MAKE - AS NEW

- **Cuddlies** 1 metre square flannelette hemmed, for babies in hospital.
- **Kangas** for women hospital patients, hemmed rectangle of bright coloured cotton/cotton mix fabric (1m x 2m long).
- **Nighties** for babies and children in hospital, flannelette or stretch knit (pattern available). NOT JUMPSUITS
- **Vest, bonnet, beanies** wool mix or acrylic, any colour and any pattern.
- **Jumpers, cardigans** any style, bright colours, for children 6 months to 6 years, and adults. (5-8 ply acrylic is best)
- **Cloth Carry bags** – strong cotton, all sizes - drawstring (25cm x 35cm) up to large (30cm x 40cm minimum) with long handles.
- **Pillowslips** standard size NEW ONLY.
- **Patchwork quilts** fabric patch (2m long X 1m to 1.25m wide)
- **Rugs** knit or crochet rugs (1.5m sq)
- **Blankets** 2m long X 1.5m wide

CHILDREN'S CLOTHES for families of evangelists and pastors.

- Simple short-sleeve dress for girls aged 3-6 years. Lots of ribbon, lace.
- Top and gathered skirt (mid calf length) for girls aged 7-14 years, any style in colourful cotton/cotton mix fabric.
- Shirts/long shorts for boys aged 2-14 years.
- School shirts and blouses – white. A MUST for all primary and secondary school children.
- **Sewing fabrics and wool are available at the MAG Depot if requested.**

FIRST AID/HYGIENE - NO LIQUIDS (ALL NEW ITEMS)

Nail brushes, toothbrushes, tooth paste, wide combs (not brushes) disposable razors, razor blades, bandaids, sticking plaster, bandages, cotton wool (not cotton balls), safety pins, disposable rubber gloves, cake soap - **plain** toilet & laundry bars.

Medical/Hospital Requirements

Suitable for hospitals in Tanzania. Must have 12 month use by date only. - Surgical

- Disposable syringes 5ml/2ml
- Disposable needles 21,23 gauge
- IV Cannulae 22,20,18,16 gauge
- Gauze bandages and dressings, Masks and surgical gloves
- Sutures (chrome 1,0,2/0 3/0 or nylon 2,1 to 3/0)
- Cotton wool packs and rubber gloves
- Plastic kidney dishes, bowls, bucket

PLEASE NO MEDICATIONS, NO PHARMACEUTICALS. eg Panadol or aspirin, analgesics, cotton buds, out of date or high tech. sterile items, drugs or hearing aids. **WE CANNOT SEND THEM.**
