### WHAT IS SUMMERVIEW?

The CMS annual SummerView conference is an opportunity for Christians to experience outstanding Bible teaching and gain understanding of God's global work in making Jesus known among the nations. Attendees will be inspired and encouraged to get involved in both global and local disciple making as they hear from an international mission speaker and missionaries back on Home Assignment. A range of electives will focus on both local and global mission.

Our conference Bible teacher will be **Simon Gillham**, former CMS Missionary in Namibia and currently Head of Mission at Moore Theological College.

#### International

The International Speaker, will be **Pastor Grishma Parajuli**, Senior Pastor of Nayagaun Church, Pokhara, Nepal.

#### CMS-A Staff and Missionaries back on home assignment

**Chris Cooper**, CMS Regional Mission Director for SE Asia, will educate us on what CMS is doing in the world and what opportunities for mission exist. Our own **T and E** back from SE Asia, as well as CMS NSW missionaries **Joel and Tiff Atwood** from Vanuatu will share with us what God has been doing through their faithful obedience to his call to go to the nations.

#### CMS Tasmania's newest missionaries

We will also meet **Amanda and Maurice Jacobson**, before they head to St Andrews Hall for their five-month cross-cultural training course, complete their initial Home Assignment and then, God willing, deploy to Cambodia to support a rural bible school.

### CHILDREN AT SUMMERVIEW

During our morning sessions, where we have both bible teaching and a keynote address from our International Speaker, children and youth are catered for with their own programs: **creche, primary and youth**.

On the Thursday evening there will be a supervised movie night for children aged 4-12, during the conference opening.

On the Friday and Saturday evening, we will hear from our missionaries back on Home Assignment as well as skyping into our workers overseas. Primary aged children and youth are welcome to come and hear from our missionaries.

Each afternoon offers one elective session, but also plenty of free time.

### ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

Camp Banksia is a beachside camp and conference centre located at Port Sorell on Tasmania's north-west coast, 17 km east of Devonport and an hour's drive from Launceston. For more details, visit [www.campbanksia.com](http://www.campbanksia.com)

## SUMMERVIEW SPEAKERS



### Bible

**Simon Gillham** will teach us from the book of Colossians over four teaching sessions. Simon has been the Head of the Department of Mission at Moore College since returning to Australia in 2016. Before this Simon and his wife Margie served as CMS missionaries in Namibia where Simon was the principal of a small Bible college, and their two children completed High School. Simon and Margie enjoy meeting people from all kinds of different backgrounds and cultures and sharing the love of the Lord Jesus with them. They also enjoy time with their adult children, cruising on their motorbike and sailing together.



### International

**Grishma Parajuli** is the senior pastor of Nayagaun church in Nepal, where he has been serving now for more than 30 years. Originally from a high-caste Hindu background, Grishma became a Christian after investigating Christianity closely in an attempt to disprove it. He was especially impressed by Jesus' teaching in the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7), and so put his trust in Jesus despite intense family pressure. Today his church of 1000 people has planted 11 churches with which he retains links. Several Australian CMS missionaries are part of the Nayagaun church and work in fellowship with him and his wife Laxmi.



### CMS-A Staff and Missionaries back on home assignment

**Chris Cooper** is currently one of CMS Australia's three Regional Mission Directors pastorally responsible for around seventy-five adult cross-cultural workers, mainly in SE Asia. Chris was formerly a missionary in SE Asia.
