Policy

CMS-A is committed to:

- Adopt a zero-tolerance approach to fraud, corruption (including any bribery);
- Conduct our business in an honest and ethical manner; acting fairly and with integrity in all our business dealings and relationships wherever we operate;
- Taking reasonable steps to minimise any risk of corruption, fraud, bribery or other financial impropriety; upholding all laws relevant to countering fraud, bribery and corruption in all the jurisdictions in which we operate.
- Take reasonable steps to identify and document any perceived or actual material conflicts of interest for their employees, volunteers, third parties and responsible entities outside Australia.
