



## *Young Adult Director & Young Adult Intern*

CMS is offering two roles for work with Young Adults: Young Adult Director and Young Adult Intern. These roles are intended to be part-time, however the exact number of days for each role will be part of the interviewing process and the possibilities with the successful candidates. It is intended that the roles would have a 2-3 year cycle. The YA Director will lead the team and have more experience, but with a desire to learn and grow; the YA intern will be ready to learn and develop.

### **Position Objective**

- To foster and develop a community of Young Adults who will be inspired to pray, care, give and go. Our vision is to See a World That Knows Jesus.

## *Key Responsibilities*

(shared between the two roles)

### **Young Adult Engagement (70%)**

- Create and build a community amongst Young Adults through connecting with and working through already established Young Adult spaces:
  - SUTS Camp (Summer Under the Son) Youth leader community
  - SIIM groups (Seriously Interested in Mission)
  - MentAC (Mentoring Across Cultures: a two year program for learning to engage cross culturally)

- Create and implement targeted cross-cultural input that inspires and encourages Young Adults. This includes:
  - Facilitating relationships with existing or past missionaries through podcasts and mentoring.
  - engaging the next generation of Young Adult leaders in our existing training and mobilisation pathways.
  - Inspiring targeted cross-cultural mission evenings with cross-cultural speakers.
- Promote MentAC, SIIM groups and other CMS-V events amongst Young Adult communities.
- Coordinate existing SIIM groups and establish new groups when required.

### Go Explore (20%)

- Plan one online/on-location Go Explore (short-term mission experience) for the CMS Young Adult community.

### Strategic Relation and Participation (10%)

- Cultivate strategic relationships with like-minded Young Adults in the churches they attend.
- Participating for CMS at events where Young Adults gather (e.g. AFES NTE, Belgrave Heights Conventions, Ridley College, MST, SU events)

## *Selection Criteria – qualification and experience*

### Essential

- A passion for cross-cultural mission and communicating the CMS Vision
- A strong desire to grow and develop skills in how the Bible shapes cross-cultural mission and discipleship
- Excellent capacity to engage with Young Adults
- Strong leadership and team management skills: ability to train, mentor and empower team members (staff and volunteers)
- Capacity for forward planning
- Very good interpersonal skills
- Strong computer skills, (including Microsoft and social media)



## Desirable

- Some experience in preaching and teaching
- Open to pursuing formal theological study
- Considering long-term cross-cultural work

## Personal Qualities

- Servant-hearted and teachable
- Ability to deal with a wide range of issues, to set priorities and work under pressure
- Ability to manage relationships between staff, CMS Victoria members and supporters, and to gain the confidence and respect of missionaries.
