WHAT IS SUMMERVIEW?

The CMS annual SummerView conference is an opportunity for Christians to experience outstanding Bible teaching and better understand God's global work in making Jesus known among the nations. Attendees will be inspired and encouraged to get involved in global and local disciple-making as they gain an international perspective on mission challenges and opportunities in Europe, South Asia and Latin America. Electives will focus feature our workers back on Home Assignment and explore how to apply global mission learnings to local mission in Australia.



SPEAKERS



Bible

Our conference Bible teacher will be **Richard Condie**, CMS TAS President, who will be teaching us from the book of Micah. Richard heads up the Anglican Church in Tasmania and is an in-demand Bible teacher.



International

Leonardo De Chirico, Vice-Chairperson of the Italian Evangelical Alliance, will give the evening talks at SummerView. Leonardo will cover the ongoing relevance of the Reformation protest, the problem with the Roman Catholic gospel, and evangelism in (nominally or genuinely) Roman Catholic countries.



Missionaries back on home assignment

Our own **K** (secure worker, Allied Health and one-to-one discipling, South Asia), **R** (secure worker, Eurasia) and **Peter Sholl** (Theological Education, recently returned from Mexico), will each give a keynote session about mission joys, challenges and opportunities in South Asia and Latin America. You will also be introduced to our CMS TAS Co-Mission Partners, **Bryan and Sarah Haro Leon** who will head to Ecuador in May 2023.



Electives

Our Friday afternoon electives will allow attendees to think about how they might apply global mission learnings to mission in Tasmania. It also aims to educate supporters on how best to care for our workers when deployed and when back in Australia on Home Assignment.

CHILDREN

Children will be looked after in their own creche, primary and high-school programs, which run during the main sessions but not during the evening or elective sessions. High-schoolers will have trained mentors to guide their learning as they attend the missionary keynote presentations. Parents can bring their children to the evening and elective sessions where appropriate. Pencils and colour-in activities will be provided. High-schoolers will benefit from the electives and evening sessions and are most welcome.

ACCOMMODATION

A caravan park is located next door to the conference venue: **Big 4 Launceston Holiday Park**. Big 4 is where many attendees and keynote speakers stay.

Big 4's website indicates a minimum three-night stay, but **SummerView attendees can book just the two necessary nights**, 12 and 13 January. **To obtain a two-night booking, phone 6344 2600** and mention you are coming to Launceston for the CMS Tasmania conference at Door of Hope Church.

There are also many other accommodation options in Launceston.

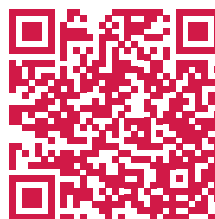
