# **CENTRAL ASIA**

Central Asia is made up of many countries, and is situated between Europe, South Asia and East Asia. Around 72 million people live here and the majority religions are Islam and Hindu. Many people here don't know Jesus and some don't ever get a chance to even hear about him. CMS missionaries share about God's love with people and use their skills in healthcare, agriculture and other areas to support communities in Central Asia.


CMS

There are many nomadic people groups living in Central Asia. This means they don't have permanent homes and instead move from place to place according to the seasons. A type of housing they live in is called a 'yurt', which is like a large circular tent. Make your own mini yurt here:

**You will need:** scissors, colour pencils or textas, glue stick or tape. Ask an adult if you need help cutting with the scissors.

- 1 Colour in your yurt—you may even want to design some patterns for it!
- 2 Cut out the circle. Bring the two ends together and either glue or tape it securely in place. This will be the top of your yurt.
- **3** Cut out the rectangle. Bring the two ends together and either glue or tape it securely in place. This will be the base of your yurt.
- 4 Put your yurt together. You're done! You can now move your yurt around easily.
