



ACTIVITY


Camels are used to transport people and goods in the Middle East. They are also referred to as the 'ships of the desert'. Learn how to draw your own camel by following the steps below:




1. Draw an oval and a small circle. Connect it with two curved lines and add a rounded square for its nose.



3. Use ovals, long lines and triangles to draw its legs. Make sure to slightly change the angles so it looks realistic.



2. Add in a semicircle on top of the oval for its hump and two smaller ovals for its ears.



4. Erase some of the lines that overlap and add in some details. You're done!

It is considered rude to eat or drink using your left hand in the Middle East.




Fun fact:
